#### **2. CORRESPONDENCE**

#### **3. AGENDA ITEMS**

##### **a) 2013 Australian Championships**

The ESDO updated the committee as to the plans in process for the Trampoline State team, including;

- The trampoline team will be staying at the Homebush Bay Novotel, meaning transport vehicles will not be required.
- Meals will be provided via the hotel, where joint meeting and dining rooms will be established for all NSW teams.

##### **b) GNSW Awards Policy**

D. Ryan communicated his suggestions as to potential changes to the Gym NSW Awards Policy for trampoline awards, covering Australian representative points, sub-junior tumbling and entry ratio's.

Following in-depth discussion, the SMC agreed the entire policy should be re-looked at to provide for more accurate and fair awards (for the 2014 competition season)

**c) Coaching Structure Update**

The ESDO gave a quick update as to the coaching structure update, with more to be communicated in the coming weeks.

**d) Professional Development Conference 2014** (course deadline: 31<sup>st</sup> July)

The committee had a quick discussion as to potential trampoline inclusion in the 2013 Conference.

**e) Intermediate Judging Course**

The SMC voiced concerns with the lack of planning for the recent Intermediate Judging course, which despite being booked well in advance, was not prepared for sufficiently. Of particular concern was; no Powerpoint material ready for the course, no equipment being setup.

The SMC shared similar concerns with the quality of the supervisor course.

#### 4. General Business

- S. Roberts queried who NSW had nominated for the Continental Judges course. The nominees were communicated as being; G. Needham, S. Roberts, D. Ryan, B. Cox, M. Jennings and K. Dunn.

- D. Ryan communicated his election to the chair of the national athletes commission, which, pending the position forming part of the Gym Australia board, may require him from stepping down from the NSW committee.

- V. Catto communicated that it would be worth hiring an individual to assist in setting the Swescore network up for the first trial.
